

St. Maron Council Meeting: 4 Nov 2012 (12:13 to 1:01 pm).

Present: GK Rudy Mack, FS Dan Barton, Treasurer Ron Foster, Recorder John Handley, Trustee Bill Hoadley, Geronimo Campanile, and DD Rod Kamlofskey.

GK Rudy led us in prayer (Our Father) and in the Pledge of Allegiance.

Minutes for October were read, modified as required, and approved.

Membership: FS Dan reported that, with Brian Chase's passing, our council now has 31 members.

Treasurer Ron stated we had \$630.01 in our account and the question of excess funds was resolved.

FS Dan explained we had a deposit of \$190 inadvertently deposited into our account by the Assembly's purser. Dan requested \$11.44 reimbursement for his expenses (stamps, printing, etc.).

LAMB: Bill Hoadley stated that the one weekend (mid-Oct) at CGA (White Church) was the best in ages with \$601 collected, for a total to date of 739. We have one more weekend—mid-Nov—to finish Operation LAMB. Bill encouraged everyone to sign up on the web page for 2-hour shifts.

Old Business: (1) John reported that the Thanksgiving food card donations are strong with \$595 collected to date for 17 cards @ \$35 each. This next weekend will be the last for the Thanksgiving collection and subsequent donations will go for Christmas food cards. Ron mentioned that we needed to ask father Sam to put a "thank you" note in the bulletin for parishioner support. (2) Knights helped MJ and her committee set up for the parish sponsored Lebanese Dinner on 13 October. (3) Ron again reminded the Knights of the monthly Adoration/Rosary/Benediction (ARB) at 6:30 the first Tuesday of each month and encouraged attendance since the gathering was initiated by Seminarian and Knight Ian. The next ARB will be 6 November, election day.

New Business: (1) FS Dan passed out CD's from Supreme for the 2012-13 K of C Service Kit. (2) Dan passed around a letter from Holy Angles that explains what they do. (3) Dan discussed Heritage House and their respect for life/pro-life staff. (4) Bill requested assistance for Mary Dashought who needs a truck to help her move a purchase from an estate sale. Rod agreed to drive and help Bill load it.

DD Comments: (1) Rod stated the next phase of the soccer competition for Youth would be held in Swansboro. (2) He said he has a 1st degree on 19 Dec at Ft Bragg and asked us to host just a 2nd in November. We agreed to host it on the 17th at 6:30 p.m. Rod will provide the degree team although he may be looking for someone to play the role of the GK. (3) Rod congratulated the council for Operation LAMB, the Thanksgiving food cards, support to Ian (Seminarian) and support to Ron (soon to be deacon).
